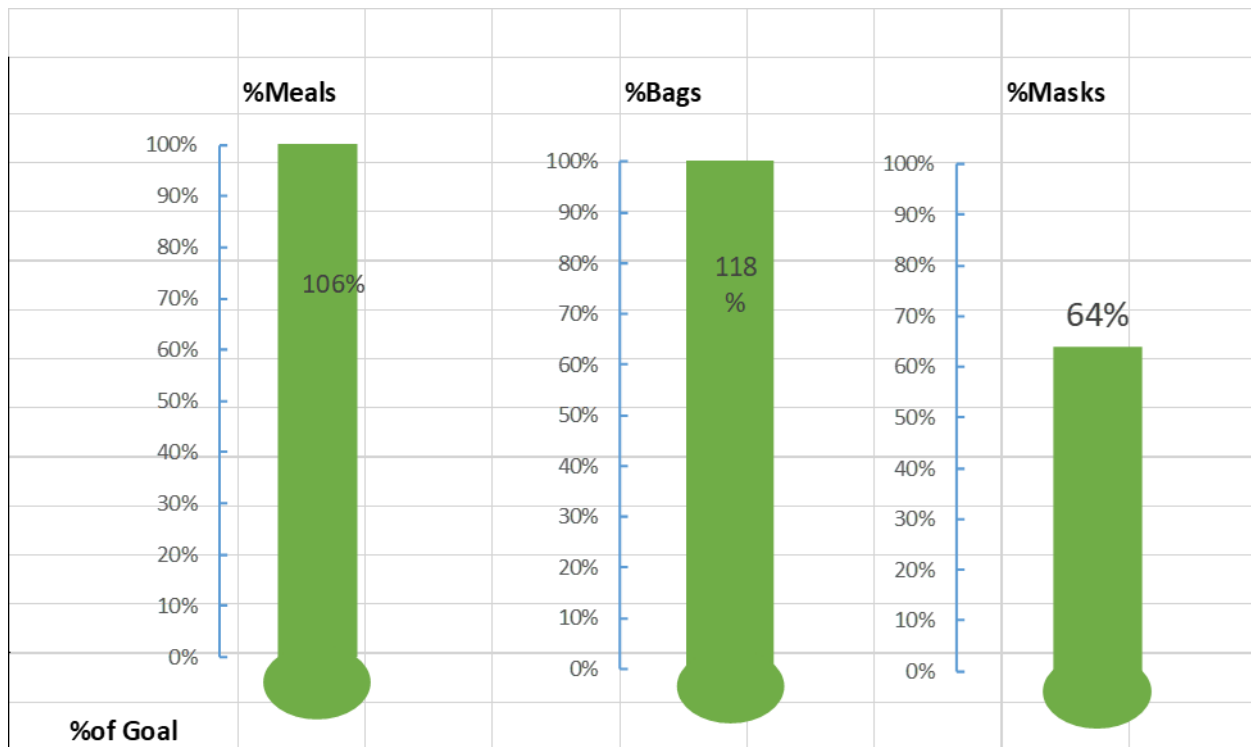
Meals for Meds = \$530 raised (\$500 goal)

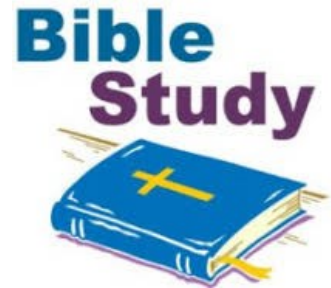
Fellowship at CLC
