Luke 13:10-17

¹⁰Now he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. ¹¹And just then there appeared a woman with a spirit that had crippled her for eighteen years. She was bent over and was quite unable to stand up straight. ¹²When Jesus saw her, he called her over and said, "Woman, you are set free from your ailment." ¹³When he laid his hands on her, immediately she stood up straight and began praising God.

The woman, when she entered the synagogue, was bent over and quite unable to stand up straight. For 18 years, she had been pulled down, as if by an unseen weight. Have you ever felt that way? Physically, emotionally, spiritually weighed down? The weight can come in many forms—illness, grief, transition that is just too much, financial stress, broken relationships. Whatever the form, we struggle to move. We can't seem to even raise our heads to see what is around us. Often when we hear this story, we hear one miracle, the physical healing that restored the woman's body and straightened her spine. But there is a second miracle, one that is not at all unusual for Jesus.

When we are weighed down, our view becomes limited, our head bowed and face toward the ground. We feel invisible, and all too often, we are. When the woman entered the synagogue, Jesus saw her. He knew her pain. Whatever held her down, he understood it. And Jesus called out to her, and lifted the weight. After 18 years, she could raise her head and look around her. After 18 years, she finally knew she was not alone. The second miracle.

And that, for Jesus, is what community is all about. Bearing the challenges of life together. Raising each other up. Seeing one another, exactly as we are. Knowing we are not alone.

For 125 years, Christ Lutheran Church has been a community, together. We have followed the Spirit, embodied the love of Christ for one another and the community around us, been a presence of God's healing in the midst of pain, continued to open the doors wider, welcoming and serving in many ways over the years.

This fall, we celebrate Christ at work in and around us for a century and a quarter. Like the woman in our Gospel, we will tell the stories, so everyone will know the abundance of God. And, like the woman, we will lift our hearts to see where the Spirit is leading in the years to come. We may not know where we are headed yet, but we do know there are so many miracles to come. Join us as we celebrate and follow the Spirit to welcome and serve!

TECH TEAM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED


