A Note from Pastor Meagan



Isaiah 63:7-9

⁷I will recount the gracious deeds of the LORD, the praiseworthy acts of the LORD, because of all that the LORD has done for us, and the great favor to the house of Israel that he has shown them according to his mercy, according to the abundance of his steadfast love. ⁸For he said, "Surely they are my people, children who will not deal falsely"; and he became their savior ⁹in all their distress. It was no messenger or angel but his presence that saved them; in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; he lifted them up and carried them all the days of old.

And just like that, Christmas Day is past, and the year is about to roll over officially to 2023. It's hard to believe we are almost into a new year! It is a time when many set New Year's Resolutions, jokingly commenting that it is likely these commitments will be broken by Valentine's Day, if not before! Our readings today invite us to look at the new year differently, once again exchanging our expectations designed for failure for expectations filled with grace.

Isaiah says he will recount the grace of God, those moments when God has been present, shown mercy, shown abundance, shown love. Isaiah claims that it is the presence of God that saves and carries him, and all of us, from the beginning until this very day. What a life-giving focus to begin the new year! So, instead of making and sharing (an maybe breaking) resolutions, I hear Isaiah inviting us to take some time to open our minds and spirits to the presence of God, allowing that to fill and guide us in the new year.

Questions for Reflection

Where have you seen God at work this year? Who has revealed God's grace, love, and peace to you in this season? Tell the stories of God's presence in our lives and communities.

Where are areas of struggles, or challenge, that you invite God into as the new year begins? Who can you share this prayer of hopeful expectation with, as Isaiah shared his hopes with the people of Israel?

We have just begun our fall stewardship invitation. Please see the pledge form at the back of the newsletter and contact Katie Ciorba with any questions.


We can continue to fund our church and the important work we're doing with a few easy clicks:

2023 Council Openings: We Need You!

Each chair serves a two-year term and meets once a month with the rest of Council to discuss and decide important church issues. Below is a description of all the positions that are open. We hope that you will prayerfully consider joining the Council in continuing the good works at Christ Lutheran Church. If you are interested, please send Lisette an email or call the office!

Inreach: Responsible for ensuring a fulfilling experience at Christ Lutheran for current members, during and outside of the service. This involves making sure people have access to the service and soliciting ideas for possible improvement. Inreach also provides support to other committees, especially the Fellowship and Worship committees, as there is a fair amount of overlap between them. During COVID, Inreach has helped coordinate all the technology for the Zoom church services. Other jobs include planning the 4th of July festivities, welcome and birthday parties.

Outreach: Responsible for helping promote Christ Lutheran Church in the local community, raising awareness and piquing the interest of potential new members/the community in CLC services, events, etc. While each outreach chair is empowered to work with their committee to determine a plan and initiatives for their work, a few common, primary responsibilities include planning and promoting holiday services and other events open to the community.

Worship (co-chair with John Hoffman): Work with Worship committee and musicians to help to plan worship, including scheduling worship volunteers who assist with services on Sunday mornings.

Properties: Coordinate all property-related projects. Schedule repair services as needed.
