Upcoming Forums:

May 1- Diane Drollinger, Katie Ciorba, and Pastor Meagan will lead a discussion on how we, as a congregation and as individuals, can best help survivors of sexual abuse, even when we don't know who they are.

May 8- Mark and Janet Roock will be facilitating a discussion of *The Sum of Us: What Racism Costs Everyone and How We Can Prosper Together*. Members of Christ Lutheran, along with members of neighboring congregations, have read this book, held Zoom discussions and gained insights into how racism costs everyone. Please join us for this worthwhile presentation in person or on Zoom after church on May 8. May 15- Life at Christ Lutheran after COVID. As we sincerely hope that the major disruptions from the pandemic are over, Adult Forum once more and perhaps finally explores our congregation's response. **Dr. Philip Mudd**, Assistant Professor of Emergency Medicine at Washington University will give us a view of the future as we live with COVID-19 and answer questions. Congregational President, **Jessica Gunther**, will join him.

On Sunday 4/24, Mark Langston, general Manager of the Webster Rock Hill Ministries (WRHM) radio station presented in the adult forum. He shared the various types of assistance they provide to area families including food (donated pantry items and vouchers), utility assistance, tutoring for area children, and nursing services through Deaconess Health Ministry. In March, WRHM assisted 231 individuals/181 families. They also sponsor a local radio station KWRH located on 92.9 FM or also online at www.kwrhg29.org including local programming and information.

WRHM was started in 1982 as a response to the recognized needs of people in the community. They are currently supported by 31 area churches. The Christian Service Committee selected WRHM to be one of our partner benevolent agencies for 2022 due to their focus on basic needs in our surrounding community.
